

Seward Scholarship Competition

Seward Scholarships are awarded annually to members of Alpha Delta Phi Society on the basis of academic achievement and contribution to the Fraternity. All undergraduates who will be active members of their local chapter during the 2006-2007 academic year are invited to apply.

Scholarships are awarded only to **full time** students and must be used to meet direct educational expenses such as room, board, tuition, and books. Scholarships will range from \$500-\$1,000 and are awarded on a competitive basis.

The 2006-2007 Seward Scholarship competition will be conducted in three stages.

1. **Submission of Seward Scholarship Application, and Official Transcript.**

Complete the application form (SewardApplication.doc or SewardApplication.PDF.) It must be submitted to the Seward Scholarship Committee no later than June 17, 2006. The Seward Scholarship Application should be prepared by the student. Finally, the applicant **must** have his college send an official transcript of grades to the Committee.

2. **Solicitation of Evaluations.**

The Awards Committee **may** solicit evaluations of specific applicants. The Committee will consult members of the Fraternity who are able to evaluate the applicant's contribution to his local chapter. All evaluations will be obtained no later than July 15, 2006.

3. **Selection of Scholarship Recipients.**

The Committee will announce all scholarship recipients at the Fraternity's Annual Convention held in Boston – Somerville, MA , on August 11-13, 2006. Society winners will also be announced at the next Society Convention. Scholarship checks will be issued in one or two installments during that current academic year.
